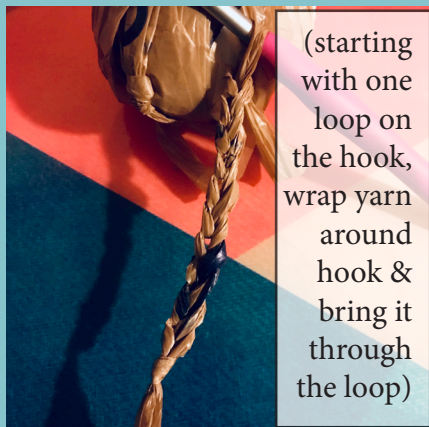

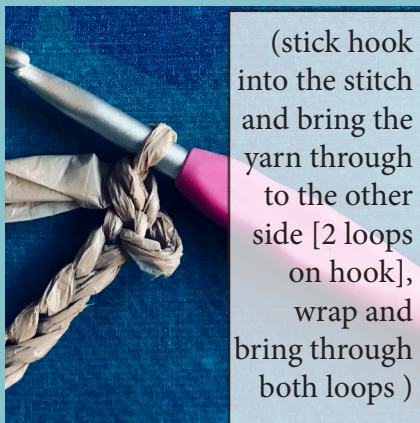
# ABBREVIATIONS/CHEAT SHEET:

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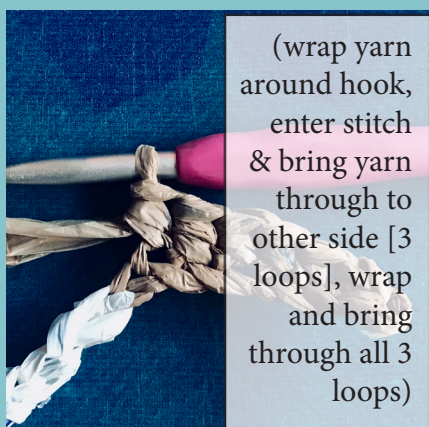
## **ch:** chain stitch



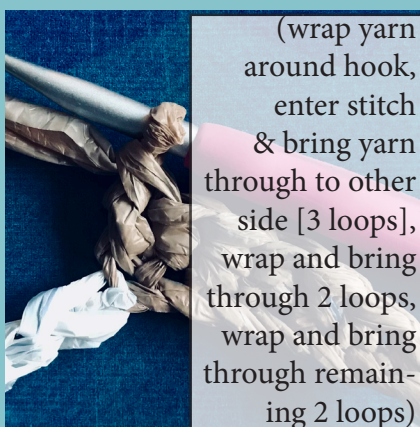
## **sc:** single crochet



## **hdc:** half double crochet



## **dc:** double crochet



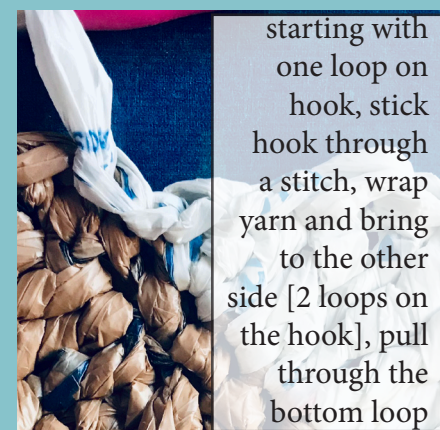
**tc:** triple crochet



**quad:** quadruple crochet



**quad inc:** 2 quadruple crochets in the same stitch   **sl st:** slip stitch

## PETAL 1:



**ch 10**



work **9 sc** back  
down the chain



In the 1st stitch,  
work:  
**(1sc, 1hdc, 1dc)**



In the 2nd stitch,  
work:  
**(1tc, 1quad)**



In the 3rd stitch,  
work:  
**(quad inc)**



In the 4th stitch,  
work:  
**(1 quad, 1tc)**





In the 5th stitch,  
**1tc**



In the 6th stitch,  
**1hdc**



In the 7th stitch,  
**1hdc**



In the 8th stitch,  
**1sc**



In the 9th (center  
stitch) work:  
**(1sc, ch1, slst, 1sc)**

**ch 8**



**work 7 sc back down the chain**



**sl st back into the starting chain again**



**move yarn around back, hook across front, and sl st into first chain**

(1tc, 1quad)**

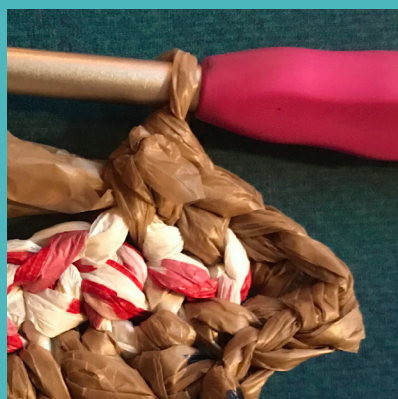

ch 8



Last stitch

## **PETAL 1:**

**ch 10,**

work **9sc** down the chain,

In the 1st stitch, work: **(1sc, 1 hdc, 1dc)**

In the 2nd stitch, work: **(1tc, 1quad)**

In the 3rd stitch, work: **(quad inc)**

In the 4th stitch work: **(1quad, 1tc)**

In the 5th stitch, **1tc**

In the 6th stitch, **1hdc**

In the 7th stitch, **1hdc**

In the 8th, **1sc**

In the 9th(center stitch), work: **(1sc, ch1, sl st, 1sc)**

## **GOING DOWN THE OTHER SIDE OF PETAL 1:**

In the 1st stitch, **1hdc**

In the 2nd stitch, **1hdc**

In the 3rd, **1tc**

In the 4th, **(1tc, 1quad)**

In the 5th, **(quad inc)**

In the 6th, **(1 quad, 1tc)**

In the 7th, **(1dc, 1hdc, 1sc)**

**Sl st** in the last chain

**Sl st** in the starting chain

## **PETAL 2/PETAL 4:**

**ch 8,**

work **7sc** down the chain,

**Sl st** back into the starting chain again

Move the yarn around back, move the hook  
across the front and **sl st** into 1st chain

In the 1st stitch, work: **(ch1, 1 hdc, 1dc)**

In the 2nd stitch, work: **(1tc, 1quad)**

In the 3rd stitch, work: **(quad inc)**

In the 4th stitch, **1tc**

In the 5th stitch, **1hdc**

In the 6th stitch, **1sc**

In the 7th(center stitch), work: **(1sc, ch1, sl st, 1sc)**

## **GOING DOWN THE OTHER SIDE OF PETAL 2/PETAL 4:**

In the 1st stitch, **1sc**

In the 2nd stitch, **1hdc**

In the 3rd, **1tc**

In the 4th, **(quad inc)**

In the 5th, **(1 quad, 1tc)**

In the 6th, **(1dc, 1hdc, 1sc)**

**Sl st** into the starting chain

## **PETAL 3:**

**ch 6,**

work **5sc** down the chain,

**Sl st** back into the starting chain again

Move the yarn around back, move the hook  
across the front and **sl st** into 1st chain

In the 1st stitch, work: **(ch1, 1 hdc, 1dc)**

In the 2nd stitch, work: **(1quad, 1tc)**

In the 3rd stitch, **1tc**

In the 4th stitch, **1hdc**

In the 5th(center stitch), work: **(1sc, ch1, sl st, 1sc)**

## **GOING DOWN THE OTHER SIDE OF PETAL 3:**

In the 1st stitch, **1hdc**

In the 2nd, **1tc**

In the 3rd, **(1 quad, 1tc)**

In the 4th, **(1dc, 1hdc, 1sc)**

**Sl st** into the starting chain

## **PETAL 4:** see Petal 2



## **Cheat Sheet:**

### **CH:** Chain

(starting with one loop on the hook, wrap the yarn around the hook and pull it through the loop)

### **SC:** Single Crochet

(starting with one loop on the hook, insert the hook into your stitch, wrap the yarn around and bring it through to the other side [now you have 2 loops on your hook], wrap the yarn around the hook and bring it through both loops.)

### **HDC:** Half-Double Crochet

(starting with one loop on the hook, wrap the yarn around the hook, insert the hook into your stitch, wrap the yarn around and bring it through to the other side [now you have 3 loops on your hook], wrap the yarn around the hook and bring it through all 3 loops.)

### **DC:** Double Crochet

(starting with one loop on the hook, wrap the yarn around the hook, insert the hook into your stitch, wrap the yarn around and bring it through to the other side [now you have 3 loops on your hook], wrap the yarn around the hook and bring it through 2 loops, then wrap the yarn again and bring it through the remaining 2 loops.)

### **TC:** Triple Crochet

(starting with one loop on the hook, wrap the yarn around the hook 2x, insert the hook into your stitch, wrap the yarn around and bring it through to the other side [now you have 4 loops on your hook], wrap the yarn around the hook and bring it 2 loops, then wrap the yarn again and bring it through the next two loops, then wrap again and bring it through the remaining 2 loops. )

### **QUAD:** Quadruple Crochet

(starting with one loop on the hook, wrap the yarn around the hook 3x, insert the hook into your stitch, wrap the yarn around and bring it through to the other side [now you have 5 loops on your hook], wrap the yarn around the hook and bring it 2 loops at a time, do this 4x)

### **QUAD INC:** Quad increase

(2 QUADS go into the same stitch)

### **SL ST:** Slip Stitch

(starting with one loop on the hook, insert the hook into your stitch, wrap the yarn around and bring it through to the other side [now you have 2 loops on your hook], then bring it through the first loop.

Fasten Off: After your final stitch, slip stitch to the next stitch and cut the yarn, leaving a 4-6 inch “tail” of yarn

## **Abbreviations:**

**ch:** chain

**sc:** single crochet

**hdc:** half-double crochet

**dc:** double crochet

**tc:** triple crochet

**quad:** quadruple crochet

**quad inc:** 2 quads in one stitch

**sl st:** slip stitch
